

✚ 1 Peter 3:15-16 read in the New Living Translation: “If someone asks about your Christian hope, always be ready to explain it. But do this in a gentle and respectful way.” Write what you understand this text to say and how it should shape the way a believer approaches the task of participating in “The Great Commission” of Matthew 28:19-20 and Acts 1:8.

✚ Acts 1:8 identifies the source of a Christian’s power. Behind the word for power is the concept of enabling or the ability to do. Who is the source mentioned in the verse, how can a believer tap into that source, and what keeps us from doing so?

✚ Create list of friends, neighbors, co-workers in your group and begin to pray that God will give you the opportunity to invite them to one of our Easter services where they will hear of God’s love, victory over death and hell, and the assurance of the forgiveness of sin and eternal life.
